The center is a National Historic Site and Florida Cultural Institution also housing the Cornell Museum of Art & American Culture (in the restored 1913 Delray Elementary School building), Vintage Gymnasium (c. 1926), and a newer outdoor Entertainment Pavilion, which hosts all of Delray’s major festivals.
